"It's important to know your rights and have a fair trial. I know this is only the start of an amazing chapter in my life. I know God will be by my side helping through it all." - Perla.



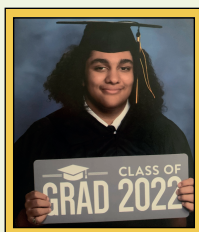
KELLEN JEFFRIES

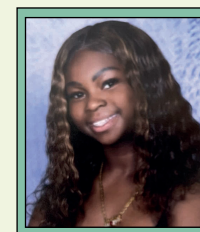
BRANDON JOHNSON
